PRE-SCHOOL GUIDE: MILLBURN (9 SCHOOLS)

The Millburn Township Public Schools' Preschool Integrated Program is located at the South Mountain Elementary School, 2 Southern Slope Drive, Millburn. The unique program is comprised of children with special needs as well as typically developing preschool children from the township. A general Preschool Curriculum is followed by all students. The District charges a monthly fee for the comprehensive services that are provided for all regular education students attending the Integrated Preschool Program. All preschool sessions are two and one-half hour classes, Monday through Friday. The three- year-old program runs in the morning from 8:15 am to 10:45 am. 


